Library

College Library provides books for the education, research and extension activity. It has upto date collection of text books, reference books and research journals.

Library Rules

- Students shall use college library, strictly as a reference library for knowledge asset.
- They will only be allowed to enter the library or avail of its facilities on production of their own valid reader card
- Library will remain open from Monday to Saturday 8.30am to 5.30pm (with Lunch Time 2.00pm to 2.30 pm)
- Books issued to borrower's card can be retained only for seven days.
- Reference/Rare books are not issued. However they can be made available in reading room.
- A fine of Rs. 5/- per day, per book will be charged for not returning it within the due date.

Reading Room

- Reading room will remain open from 8.30am to 5.30 pm on all days except Sunday.
- Admission to reading room without Identity card is prohibited.
- Students can borrow Text Books, Magazines, New Papers, Question Paperset, etc. on the Identity Card.
- Books/ Study material issued in the reading room will have to be returned before leaving reading room otherwise a fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged per day.
- Silence should be observed in the reading room.
- Indiscipline, misbehavior will not be tolerated, objectionable practices are forbidden in or near the reading room.

- Readers are responsible for any damage or injury done by them to the book or the other property belonging to the reading room and shall be required to replace such books or other property damaged or injured or to pay the full values as determined by the Principal in consolation with Reading Room in charge.

College Disciplinary Rules
